Online Tree Trimming Permit Application Checklist

- 1. Your online permit application will require the tree/palm species, quantity, area to be pruned and the location of the tree/palm on the property.
- 2. The following components are required for the online permit application:
 - (A) Current Broward County Business Tax Receipt (of the contractor performing the work).
 - (B) Valid Broward County Tree Trimming License.
 - (C) Signed and dated letter from property owner (on official letterhead for commercial and multi-family residential properties) authorizing contractor to apply for tree trimming permit on his/her behalf.
 - (D) Valid ISA Certified Arborist card.
 - (E) Arborist consent letter for supervision of pruning with site address referenced.
- 3. Pruning shall conform to Article X Landscape Standards: Sec. 27-261 of the city code of ordinances, and policies including, but not limited to:
 - Pruning trees according to ANSI A-300 Standards (available online at www.ansi.org).
 - Removing no more than 25% of the canopy of a tree and palm per pruning cycle.
 - No hat-racking, topping, over-lifting, overthinning, or lion-tailing trees.
 - Avoiding flush cuts and stub cuts on trees.
 - Removing only inflorescences/fruits and dead (brown) fronds on palm trees.
