

# PERMANENT GENERATOR PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

## The Contractor must submit the following:

### <u>APPLICATIONS REQUIRED – All applications must be submitted in a package</u>

- Electrical Permit Application
- □ Plumbing Application if fuel tank is not self contained within generator assembly.
- □ Building Application for slab if generator is larger than 20KW and slab is being poured in place. (not required if slab is pre-cast).
- Mechanical For Non-Residential Jobs
- DERD approval stamp For Non-Residential Jobs

## PLANS – THREE SETS OF THE FOLLOWING:

- □ Plans showing the electric (riser diagram) and the type and quantity of fuel (maximum 250 gallons if above ground per City Ordinance Sec. 8 3 (d)(2)).
- □ Surveys or site plans showing the location of the generator on the property. Generator must meet the setbacks of the zoning district.
- Generator specification sheets.
- Plans showing that the Generator exhaust is a minimum 10 feet from any openings (windows & doors, etc).
- Load Calculation showing the total load intended to be put on generator.
- If the transfer switch is automatic a sub panel is required, unless the generator is sized for the entire calculated load. This will prevent the generator overcurrent device from tripping when the load is transferred.
