

POOL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF REQUIREMENTS TO SUBMIT A POOL PERMIT:

NON-RESIDENTIAL/MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENCES

- Three (3) sets of signed and sealed plans.
- Plans must be stamped by the Health Department and D. E. R.D. (Development and Environmental Regulations Division).
- Three (3) surveys, showing the location of pool, patio and enclosure.
- Permits must be submitted in a complete package Building, Electric, Plumbing, Mechanical (if applicable), and either a fence or screen enclosure permit. All permits must be notarized.
- Safety Barrier Affidavit, per Florida Statutes Chapter 515, signed by the owner and Contractor.

SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCES

- Three (3) sets of signed and sealed plans.
- Three (3) surveys showing the location of pool, patio and/or enclosure.*
- Permits must be submitted in a complete package Building, Electric, Plumbing, Mechanical (if applicable), and either a fence or screen enclosure permit. All permits must be notarized.
- Safety Barrier Affidavit, per Florida Statutes Chapter 515, signed by the owner and Contractor.

Pool Permit Requirements

^{*} Plans must be approved and stamped by Winningham & Fradley if located in Plantation Acres Improvement District (P.A.I.D).
