

RESOLUTION NO. 4175

A RESOLUTION CREATING A CITY OF PLANTATION EDUCATIONAL ADVISORY BOARD AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING FOR ITS MEMBERSHIP, ITS PURPOSES, AND THE METHOD OF APPOINTMENT OF THE VOTING MEMBERSHIP THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1: Membership:

There is herewith created an Educational Advisory Board which shall have six (6) voting members on all policy recommendations with the Mayor and each Councilperson to each appoint one (1) such member all of whom shall be residents of the City of Plantation.

The appointed members shall serve from June to June at the pleasure of their appointor.

Section 2: Meetings: The City's Educational Advisory Board shall meet in City Hall at least quarterly on a date and time to be determined by Administration, having due regard for other meetings being held in City Hall. The meetings shall take place at 7:30 P.M. on the designated dates so as to assure the maximum availability of the public to any such Educational Advisory Board discussions. Each school serving students from the City of Plantation is invited to have a representative at all such meetings.

Section 3: Quarterly Reports and Minutes: The Educational Advisory Board shall submit quarterly reports to the City Council and all meetings shall be transcribed with minutes promptly furnished the City Council following such transcriptions.

The Administration shall provide such personnel as is required to prepare and transcribe such minutes of the Advisory Board's meetings.

Section 5: Purposes of Board:

The purpose of the Educational Advisory Board shall be to serve as a liaison group between the City of Plantation, the School Board of Broward County and all individual schools, public, private or parochial, which may be involved in such liaison efforts.

The Advisory Board shall promote programs and community involvement to enhance all Plantation schools, such as, but not limited to, programs to adopt a school career program with local businesses, volunteer teacher's aid programs, safety programs, etc.

The Advisory Board shall generate ideas and make policy recommendations concerning possible City involvement in finding solutions to school problems within the City of Plantation and on problems affecting the school population of citizens of Plantation who are bussed to schools outside of the City of Plantation.

The Advisory Board shall promote school site improvements through cooperative programs (such as that now generated and developing the Park East Elementary School lands and adjacent City park site).

The Educational Advisory Board may at its discretion call on any recognized public or private school group, teachers' organization, superintendant or administration for input on any recommendations, projects, programs, policies, etc., which it might wish the City Council to formulate.

The Educational Advisory Board shall undertake such additional duties as from time to time recommend or desired by the City Council of the City of Plantation.
