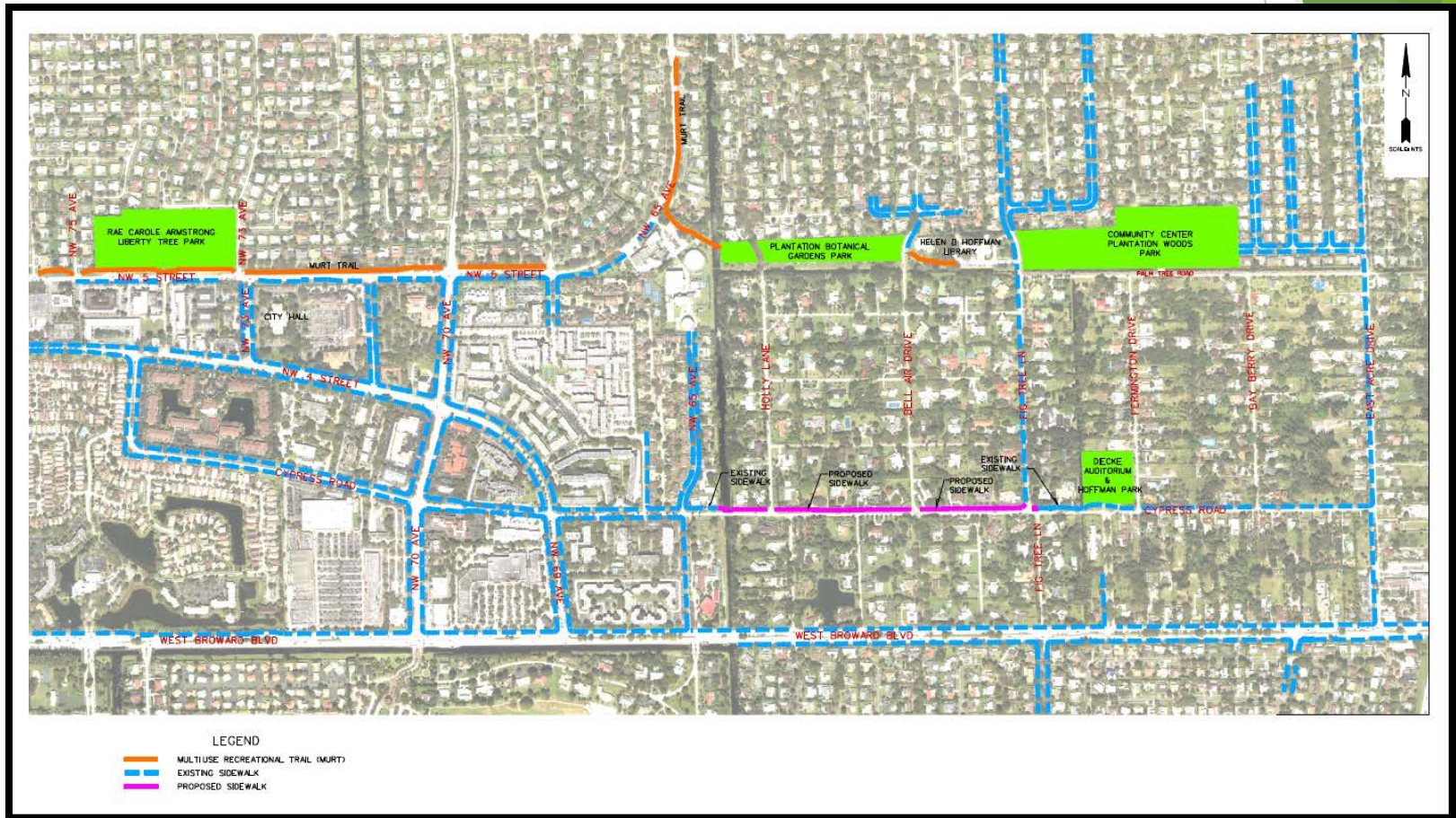

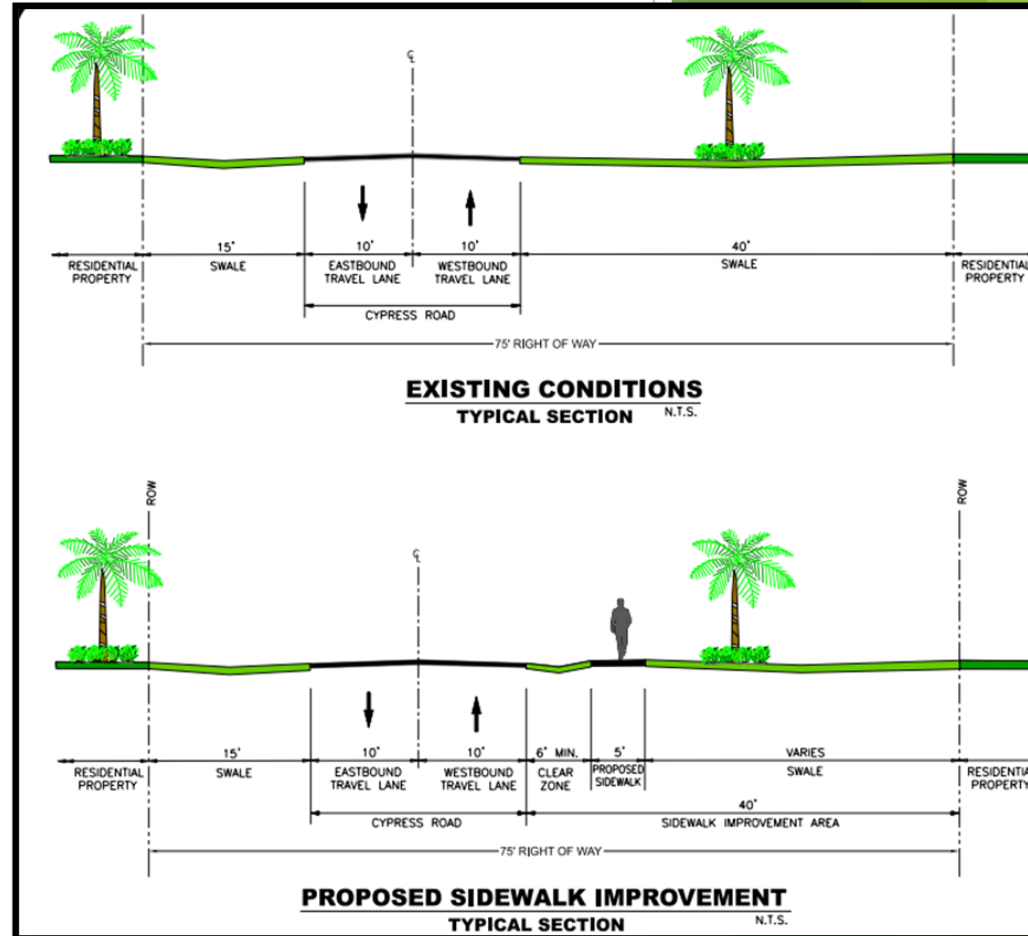
## ➤ Project Objective

The objective of the project is to enhance the pedestrian traffic connectivity from the residential developments abutting Cypress Road from NW 65th Avenue to North Fig Tree Lane and to allow local residents to access different city parks, schools, and shopping plazas on foot or bicycle.



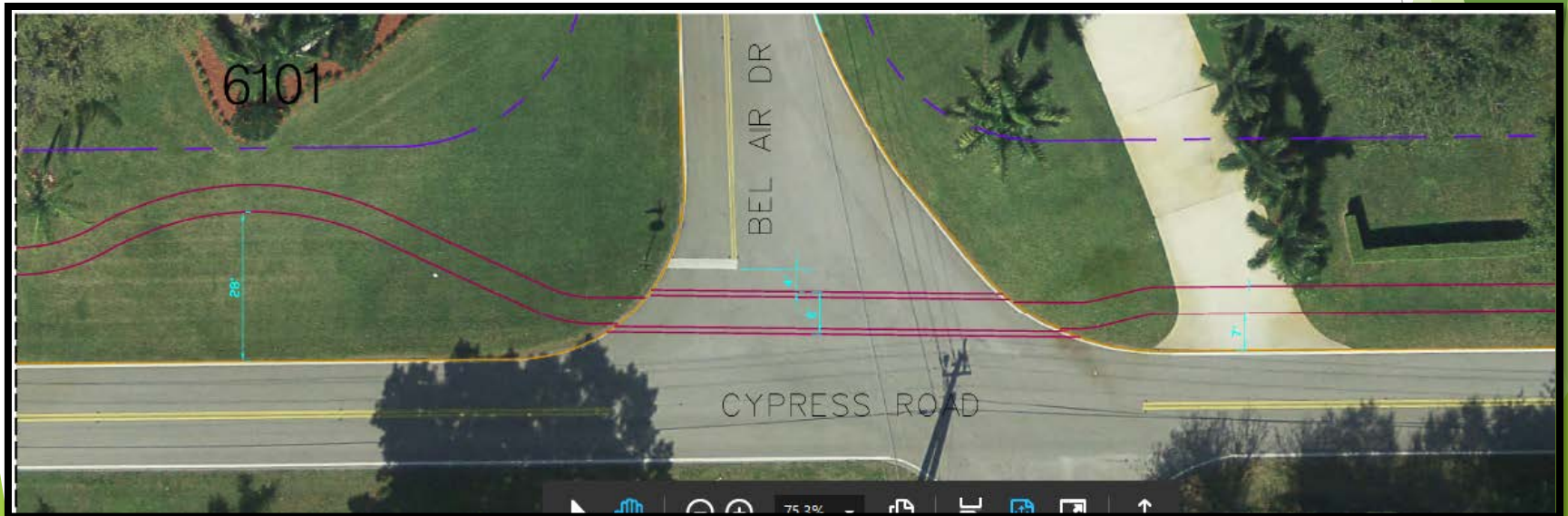
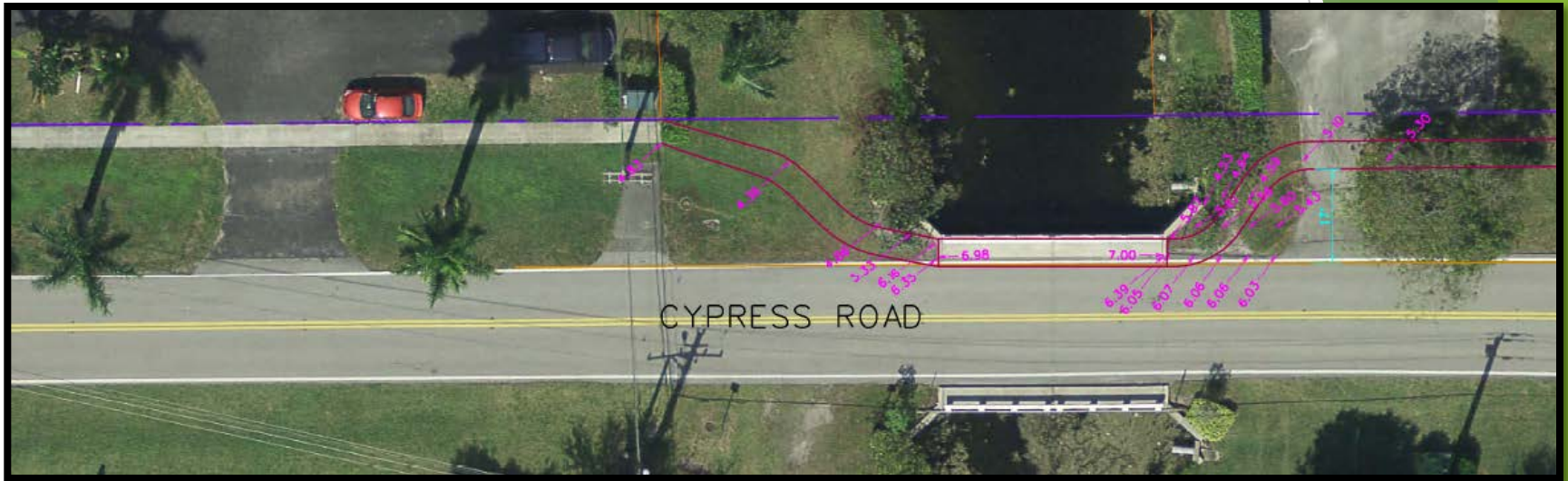
## ➤ Scope of Work

- Five (5) foot concrete sidewalk
- ADA compatible curb ramps at intersections
- Detectable warning surfaces
- New crosswalk striping
- Drainage modifications, pedestrian lighting and landscaping modifications will be provided as necessary
