1. CALL TO ORDER/Roll: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hooley

2. INTRODUCTIONS

Members went about the room and introduced themselves.

3. APPROVAL OF APRIL 22, 2021 BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Minutes approved by unanimous consent

4. GATEWAY FINANCIAL REPORT – July 2021

Mr. Holmes presented the Financial Report, attached to the minutes, and stated that revenues and expenditures are in line with previous years.

5. FY 2022 BUDGET REVIEW

Mr. Holmes presented the FY2022 Budget Review, attached to the minutes, and stated that there aren't many changes from the previous year. There is an expected increase in revenues, but no major changes otherwise.

Mr. Hooley asked about the appropriated fund balance - what were the plans for the \$110K.

Mr. Holmes replied that they were funds that go into incentive programs

Mr. Hooley replied that it wasn't in 19-20, but then it goes up by 1/3 in 2021 and inquired why.

Mr. Holmes replied legal fees have increased due to a liquor permit dispute with Plantation Inn. He added, that in addition, code enforcement has been stepped up in the area as well.

Ms. DeWet and Mr. Hooley both voiced concerns over utilizing Gateway funds for these extra legal expenses

Mr. Holmes replied that these are costs that we have to incur.

6. DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Mr. Holmes presented the Development update which is attached.

7. GATEWAY POLICING PLAN UPDATE

Lt. Rudy Brown presented that officers O'Hara and Ventura have been working with developing long term solutions with area homeless and trying to build a rapport with them to avoid issues. They have been working on maintaining high visibility to help deter crime.

Mr. Hooley asked if they would stop in and introduce themselves to the businesses in the area.

There have been approximately 1,896 events which include 101 arrests, 78 field investigations, 276 traffic stops, 26 parking tickets and 214 accidents.

8. FOLLOW-UP TO APRIL MEETING INQUIRIES

License plate camera finding

Mr. Holmes stated he was unaware of status on location or funding.

Mayor Stoner added that the LPR fell off the radar and that another vendor has been found that is more affordable and a report should be ready by next meeting to present.

District millage rate sunset date

Mr. Holmes said there was no sunset date on millage rate.

Mrs. Morris added that CRA does sunset, but Gateway does not.

Mr. Hooley asked when that date was.

Mrs. Morris replied 2030

Lauderhill meeting update

Mrs. Morris said that there have been discussions with them regarding improvements.

Mr. Brady added that he had been meeting with Lauderhill himself and the only way he can get any movement is when he deals with them himself and he would like some assistance from the City.

FPL Lighting Project (NE corridor)

Mr. Holmes stated decorative lighting from engineering, it is up and operational, the project is slated to complete in October.
