

# City of Plantation 'In Honor Of' Program

## Program Options:

### **Brick Paver (\$125)**

For \$125.00, a (4"x 8") brick paver can be installed at one of the following parks: Happy Tails Dog Park, or Rae Carole Armstrong Liberty Tree Park. While requests for installing a brick paver in a specific area within the park will be considered, it will be at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation Department. Engraving specifications: a maximum of 50 characters are allowed (up to 3 lines max), and no special characters.

\*Allow 4-6 weeks for production\*



### **Memory Tree (\$250)**

For a minimum donation of \$250.00, a memory tree can be planted at one of our parks. While requests for planting at a specific park will be considered, the tree's location, size, and variety will be at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation Department. \*Please note: the donated tree will not be marked for identification purposes, as such memory trees are not memorials, and may not be decorated with flowers, ribbons, photos, or other items\*

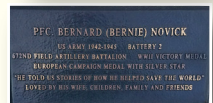


### **Bronze Plaque - for veterans and service members only (\$400-\$600)**

Pay tribute to a military service man or woman by having a bronze plaque engraved and mounted on the commemorative wall at Veterans Park. \*Allow 6-8 weeks for production\*

Two sizes are available:

- o 3"x 12" bronze plaque for \$400.00
- o 6"x 12" bronze plaque for \$600.00



## Program Policy:

Any requests to donate or plant a tree in memory or honor of a person shall be processed in accordance with the following policy:

1. Payment for program options listed shall be paid in full and due in advance, prior to production.
2. The minimum donation shall cover the costs to furnish, deliver and install the tree(s).
3. The donator shall sign a statement that he/she acknowledges and agrees to the following:
  - a. That the City has no duty to guarantee or maintain the tree(s) beyond the guarantee given by the nursery where the tree(s) were purchased.
  - b. That the City has no duty to replace the tree(s) that may die or are damaged by vandalism, weather, disease, uncontrollable acts of God, etc.
  - c. That the City may consider to transplant or replace the tree(s) that have been removed due to construction, paving, change in park design, etc.
