REGISTRATION FAQ

Q: When is registration?

A: Registration opens on April 1st, 2024 closes to waitlist on Jun 3rd, 2024, or AT CAPACITY. Late fees are added to registrations on or after May 20th, 2024.

Q: How do I register?

A: You must register with the City of Plantation.

Previous participants can register online at

parks.plantation.org. New players must register inperson at Plantation Central Park Multi-Purpose

Building. Only parents or legal guardians may
register players. You must bring birth certificate &
proof of residency to registration. For more
information, please call Central Park's front desk –
954-452-2510.

Q: What are the divisions and age rules?

A: The summer season consists of only 3 divisions. 8-9; 10-11 & 12-13. Division placement is based on the child's age as of September 1st, 2024.

Q: What is the time commitment?

A: One hour per day, three days per week.

Q: How much does it cost? What does this cost include?

A: \$145 for Plantation residents and \$195 for non-residents. A \$25 late registration fee will be charged for registrations on or after May 20th, 2024, for a total of \$170/\$220. This fee includes a player's uniform, coach's shirt, team basketball, insurance, trophies for 1st and 2nd place teams, scorebooks, game balls and the cost for officials.

Q: What equipment do I need to purchase for my child?

A: Nothing but sneakers.

Q: Are there other expenses we are responsible for?

A: No.

Q: How does the league/coaches communicate?

A: Email or text message.

SCHEDULE FAQ

Q: When/where is practice?

A: All practices will be scheduled at Plantation Central Park's outside courts or gym. Six, ½ outdoor courts are reserved for league practices.

Q: When/where are games?

A: Games will be played during the week at 6:00pm, 7:00pm, or 8:00pm and on Saturdays between 9:00am & 2:00pm. All games will be at Central Park.

Q: How are teams scheduled for practice/games?

A: Schedules are made around volunteer coaches' availability.

Q: How many games are scheduled?

A: There are 10-12 games plus at least one playoff game.

Q: When will I get a game schedule?

A: A schedule will be posted to the league website https://www.leaguelineup.com/palbiddybasketball approximately 2 weeks prior to the first game.

Q: Can you explain the playoffs?

A: Playoffs are a single or double elimination tournament format.

Q: When will the season end?

A: By the end of August.

Q: What holidays will there be no practice/games this season?

A: There will be no practice/games July 4th.

Q: Will there be an All-Star game?

A: Yes, we do hold an All-Star Game

TEAM BUILDING FAQ

Q: What are ratings and who needs to attend?

A: All participants must attend the ratings event. June 3rd, 2024, 6:30 pm, at the Central Park Gym.

Q: When will coaches be selected?

A: Prior to the drafts.

Q: What/when is the draft?

A: The draft will give the coaches a fair opportunity to choose the players for their team. This process is intended to help balance the teams as much as possible (It is always impossible to do so 100%). The draft should take place around June 6th.

Q: Who attends the draft?

A: Head coaches only

Q: When and how will I be notified which team my

Q: Will there be a picture day?

A: No, we do not hold a picture day during the summer league season.

Q: How will I be notified if a game/practice is canceled due to weather?

A: Text or email from coach.
